- Council approved an amended lease agreement for new Triland Court tenants, approved the proposed plan of subdivision and gave first reading to a zoning amendment bylaw for Triland Court. Public hearing for the zoning amendment is scheduled for November 25, 2024 at 7:00 PM.
- Council approved the proposed plan of subdivision for part of Parcel A, Plan C4715, which is the parcel of land south of the Vets Home subdivision. First reading to an Official Community Plan (OCP) amendment was given first reading and the public hearing is scheduled for November 25, 2024 at 7:00 PM.

- Municipal election officials remuneration was set by Council and the rates are consistent with the Elections Saskatchewan rates.
